
# WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

The 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits a dense ruby color and shows mixed aromas of bright fruit, cedar, ripe black berries. This medium-bodied wine shows elegance and has balanced flavors of spice box and blueberry followed by soft tannins and lightly toasted French oak to complete the gentle, lingering finish.
